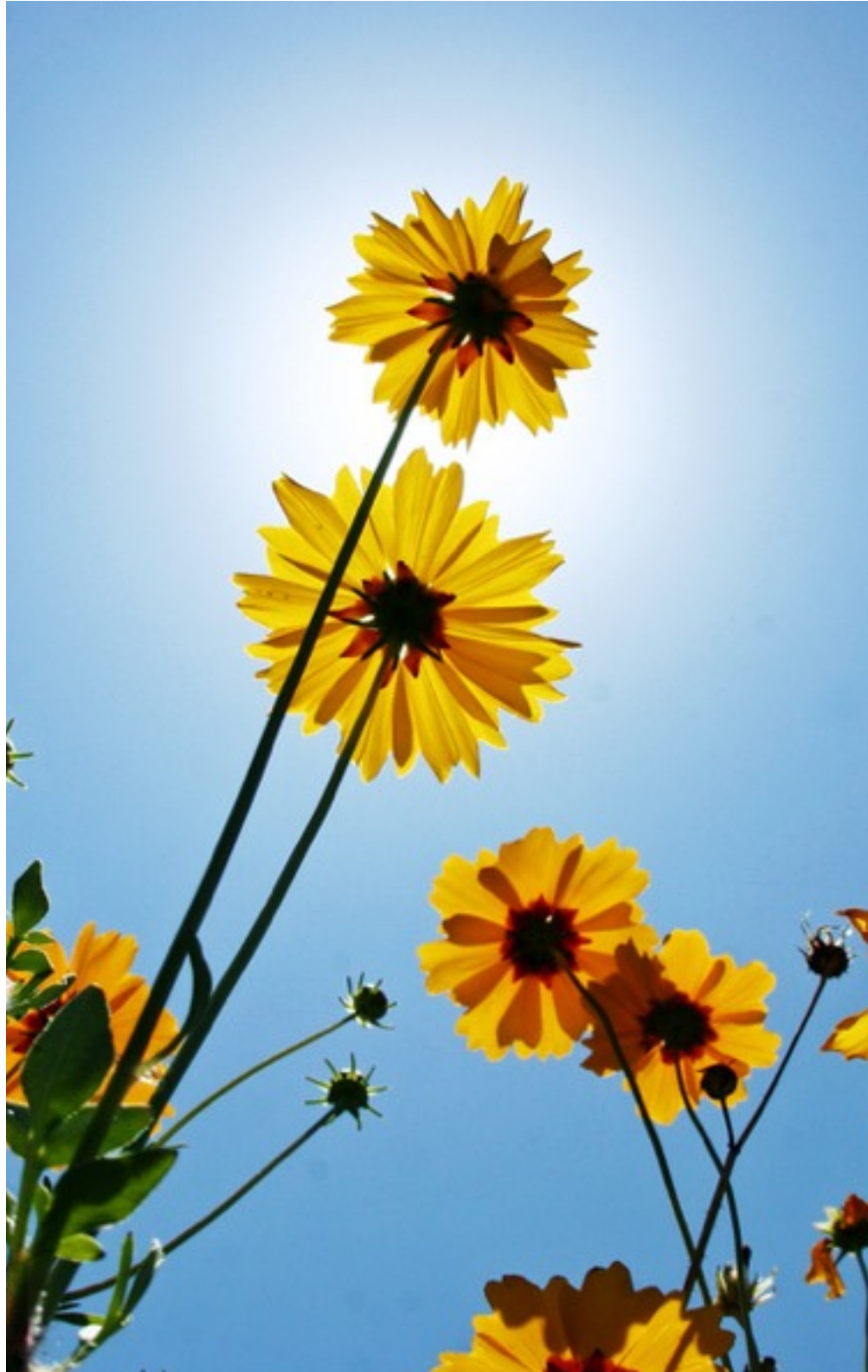

Olivet Kids is our program for children from nursery age through grade 5. There is exciting worship and teaching for the different age groups. If you are new to Olivet, feel free to come in and see what we do, and don't hesitate to ask our ushers for directions to the right room.



Ages 0-2: Nursery, downstairs and to the right near washrooms.
Ages 2-5 and Grade 1-5: Salt Cellar Room, downstairs past washrooms.

Our nursery is equipped with a number alert system. When you sign your child in, you will receive a number. If your child needs you, your number will flash at the front right of the Sanctuary. In the event of a medical need '00' will be displayed, and we request that medical professional assistance from the congregation be given as available.

If you have a baby with you in the service, there is a nursery room at the back of the Sanctuary for your convenience and privacy (you'll still be able to watch and hear the service in progress!).

Pre-Service Prayer Time: All are welcome to join us for prayer at 9:00 AM in the Edith Mann Chapel prior to the Sunday Service.

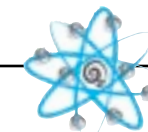
- Praise God, with Chris and Bonnie Dickson, that they are now proud grandparents of a healthy baby boy, born to Tara & Allan on July 2. God is good!
