Read Matthew 24:1-51

In A.D. 70 the temple was destroyed. Do you think verses 15-22 refer to this event or to events immediately preceding the return of Christ, or both?

How will we be able to distinguish false messiahs?

What can we know, and what can't be known about Christ's coming?

What does this chapter teach us about perseverance and watchfulness?

What does the assurance of Christ's return mean for your life, including your goals, choices, and relationships?
