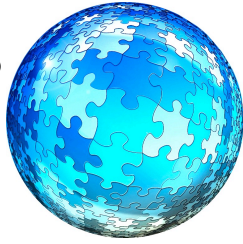


PASSPORT TO WHOLENESS

Is there anything that God has asked you to do that you have not acted on.

If so, how can the group pray or support you in responding to God's voice?

Spend extra time in prayer. Encourage those who have not prayed aloud to do so.
